PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

Georgia pecans are expected to be lighter in volume this year due to a number of reasons. Weather related issues from hurricanes, wind and rain and in some areas lack of rain. Around 100,000 trees were toppled over or on the ground with estimates of up to 60-65 million pounds lost causing many growers to quit and not replacing those trees. Estimates from growers of each state in the million of pounds are reported: Georgia 70, New Mexico 75, Florida 1, Alabama 1.5, Texas 30, Oklahoma 15, Arizona 30, California 2.5, Louisiana 6, Mississippi 1, Kansas 3, Arkansas 1, N. Carolina 1 and S. Carolina 1.

Orchards that were conditioned with fertilizer and irrigated will have more volume than the others but not above average to balance out the supplies as may be needed for the holidays. The majority of Pawnees available are contracted out. Prices for non-contracts of Pawnee that are of good quality but not for gift packs sold for about \$2.20-2.25 per pound with 48-50 count and yielding 55-58 percent. Some Pawnee with around 53 count and 53 percent sold for around \$1.90 per pound. Door prices have been reported for Elliott \$1.00-1.25 and Stuarts \$1.00 per pound, Native Seedlings \$.75 and Moneymakers \$.70-85 cents per pound. Eclipse, Oconee, Lakota and Seminole are getting ready to be sold and will be reported next week if available. Buyers are expected to be open this week or by the weekend for more sales to be reported. Size is not as large as in normal years and prices will reflect that. There have been some areas reported to have pecans with speckles and dark meat affecting quality and price. Rain has kept growers out of the orchards to gather what is left and some orchards have trees that are losing leaves causing some concern as the weather has caused slow movement. Rain today has kept most growers out of the orchards while a few have been able to get in and pick up what they could while the weather allowed.

Prices paid to growers (beginning of season late September 2023 through late afternoon Thursday, October 12, 2023) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.
